Penny Leech was born in Banbury Oxfordshire in 1947 and came to Australia in 1975. Her first botanical painting dated 1984 was done in Toodyay. She moved to Denmark in 2004 and painted daily until February 2018.

An active member of many art groups, teacher, mentor and participant of the Great Southern Art Trail for more than a decade she soon became well known for her detailed, realistic work of wildflowers, found objects and her favourite, eucalypts.

Penny also supported many other local artists her eclectic collection bore testament to this, as her walls were filled with the artwork of others. Some 350 of her originals remain and will be shown in retrospective exhibitions. As someone sadly noted that there won't be any more.
