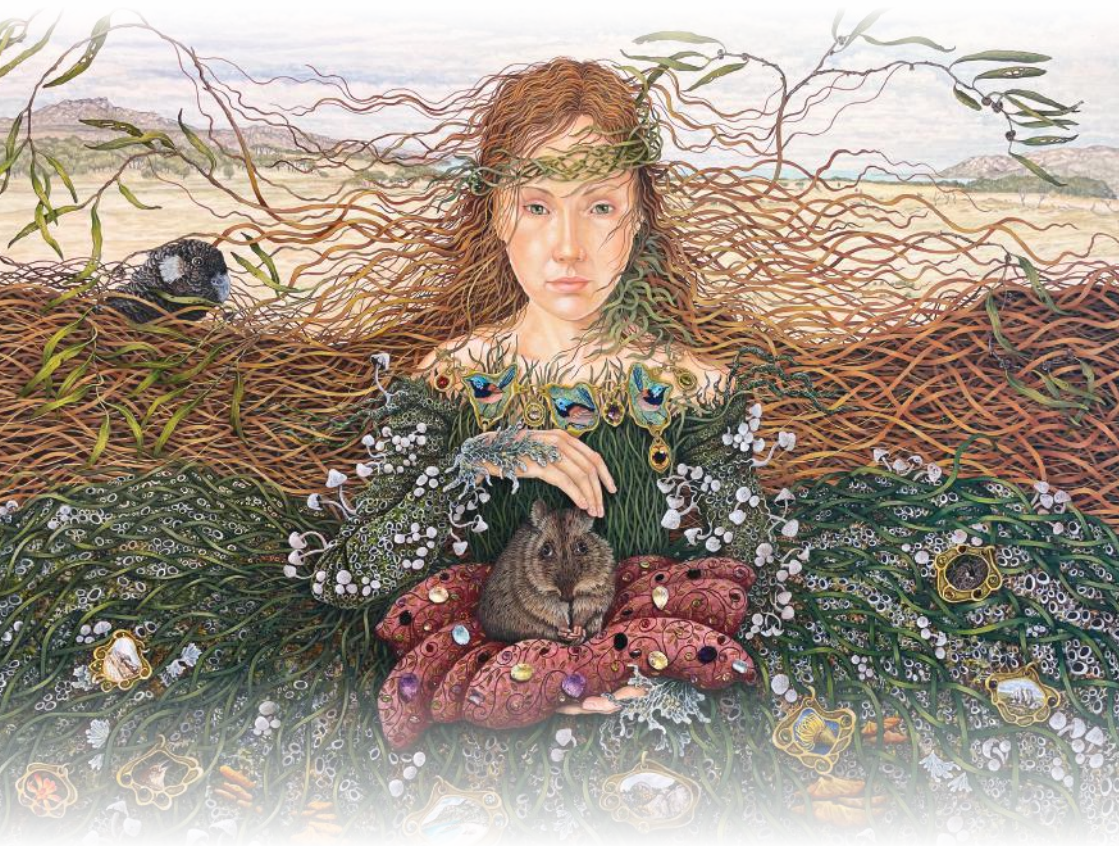

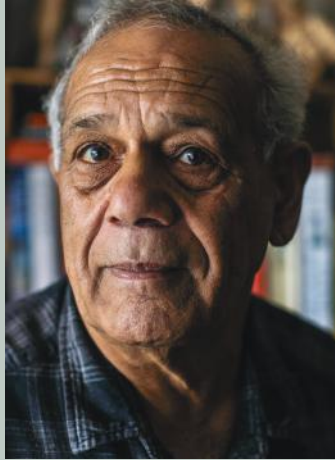

The Southern Art and Craft Trail

It began with a dedicated team from Denmark, led by Angus McKenzie formed ArtSouthWA (ASWA) in 2000 and created the first Art Trail in 2003. It featured 36 venues stretching from Walpole to Bremer Bay and multiple localities along the way.

It has grown each year as the number of exhibitions increased, peaking in 2018 to 93. Only COVID brought a halt in 2020. Venue numbers have risen back to 74 for both 2023 and 2024 with high percentages of first-time exhibitors.

Over 650 different artists and groups have taken part over the years, with many exhibiting multiple times. Notable exhibitors in 2025 who have exhibited for 20+ years are Adventures in Wood in Albany and June Smith in Denmark.

It is supported by ASWA, we support and promote hundreds of regional artists but could not do so without our volunteers, sponsors and grant providers.

The City of Albany and Tourism WA are our longest continuing Art Trail supporters. Bendigo Bank, The Great Southern Development Commission, Regional Arts WA and Regional Development Australia Great Southern are much-appreciated partners.

The Future of ArtSouthWA will continue to grow and promote opportunities for regional artists, enhancing community wellbeing, inclusivity, and encouraging visitors to explore the region. In 2025, the Easter Arts Festival was introduced and will be an ongoing annual event, creating a new opportunity for artists to showcase their work during a peak visitation period to the region.

In 2026, The Festival of Halls, as part of the Albany's bicentennial celebrations, will create another opportunity for artists, performers and the community to join together to celebrate this unique event.

This expansion is set to further ASWA's role in the artistic and cultural landscape of the Great Southern region.

Welcome Message From the Ministers:

The Albany Italian Club Mural Project, a collaborative initiative with ArtSouthWA, celebrates the 60th anniversary of the Albany Italian Club in 2025. This vibrant mural honours the enduring contributions of Italian immigrants to the Albany community, depicting symbols of Italian heritage such as a fruiting grapevine and potted olive and lemon trees—icons of traditional Mediterranean households.

The mural also reflects the historic journey of Italian migrants arriving by ship into the port of Fremantle, representing the beginning of a new life in Australia. Upon settling in Albany, families came together through the Albany Italian Club, supporting one another as they adjusted to their new surroundings. Over the years,

they preserved their culture through communal traditions—pasta, sauce, and sausage making days, as well as family dinners and dances. These beloved customs continue to be celebrated annually.

Today, generations of descendants have integrated into the broader community, contributing across all walks of life while remaining proud of their roots. The Club remains a cultural hub, welcoming all who appreciate Italian food, wine, and heritage.
