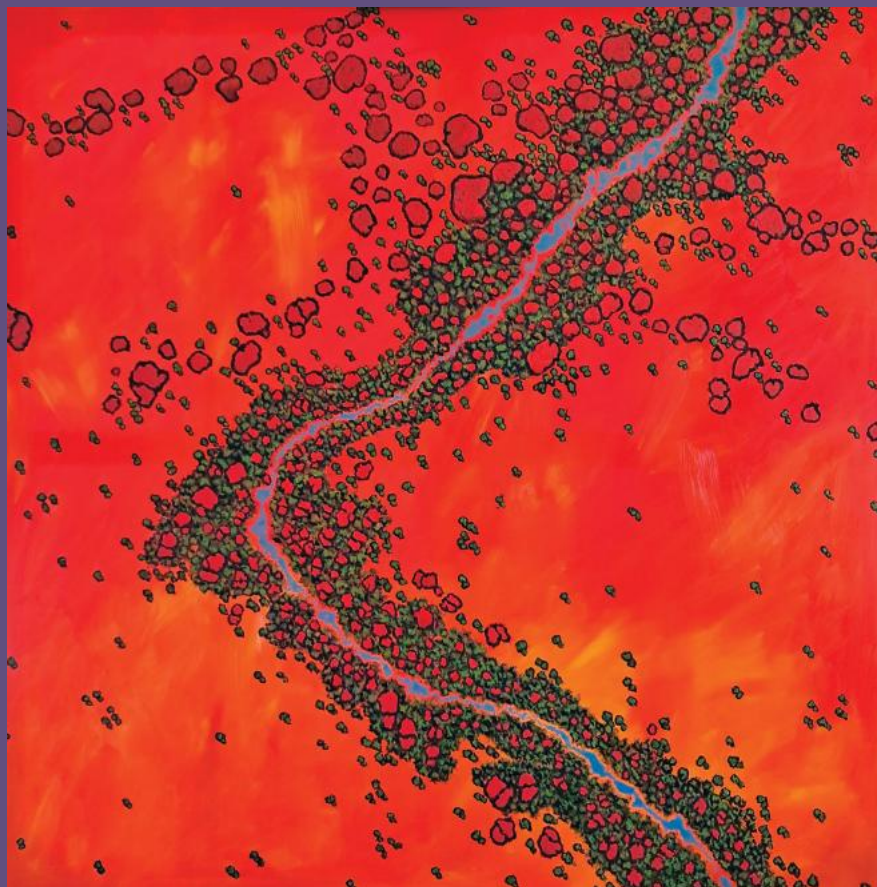

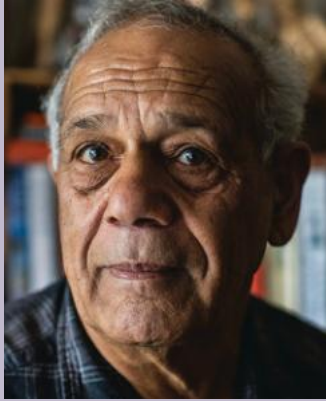

History of the Southern Art + Craft Trail

Showcasing Visual Arts for 26 years

It began with a dedicated team from Denmark, led by Angus McKenzie formed ArtSouthWA (ASWA) in 2000 and created the first Art Trail in 2003. It featured 36 venues stretching from Walpole to Bremer Bay and multiple localities along the way.

It has grown each year as the number of exhibitions grown, peaking in 2018 to 93. Only COVID brought a halt in 2020. Venue numbers have risen back to 74 for both 2023 and 2024 with high percentages of first-time exhibitors.

Over 650 different artists and groups have taken part over the years, with many exhibiting multiple times. Notable exhibitors in 2026 who have exhibited for 20+ years are Adventures in Wood in Albany and June Smith in Denmark.

It is supported by ASWA, who supports and promotes hundreds of regional artists but could not do so without their volunteers, sponsors and grant providers. The ASWA Board give over 2000 volunteer hours to produce the Art Trail, along with a part time administrator, it is more than a full time job.

The City of Albany together with Tourism WA are the longest continuing Art Trail supporters. Regional Arts WA, Bendigo Bank, The Great Southern Development Commission, and Regional Development Australia Great Southern are much-appreciated partners.

The Future, ArtSouthWA will continue to grow and promote opportunities for regional artists, enhancing community wellbeing, inclusivity, and encouraging

visitors to explore the region. In 2026, we had our second Easter Arts Festival. The event is growing and will continue in 2027 and beyond. The Easter Arts festival is creating new opportunities for artists to showcase their work during a peak visitation period to the region.

This year, The Festival of Halls as part of the Albany's bicentennial celebrations, continues throughout 2026, with more Halls and events coming on board. This has created more opportunities for artists, performers and the community to join together to celebrate this event. We are hoping to continue and expand the Festival of Halls in 2027. This expansion is set to further ASWA's role in the artistic and cultural landscape of the Great Southern region.

PREMIER'S WELCOME MESSAGE

Regional Arts WA are committed to identifying and filling creative gaps across our vast state. Funding through Regional Arts Sector Investment 2024-2027 strengthens regional arts communities where support is needed most to create, present or support relevant, diverse, challenging and exciting arts and cultural experiences for regional Western Australian communities;

The Western Australian Government is proud to sponsor these regional events, which help bring vibrancy to local communities and drive visitor spend, injecting millions into regional economies.

Tourism is a key part of our plan to diversify the economy, create jobs and develop business opportunities, especially in regional Western Australia.
